

# SUMMARY OF PET OWNERSHIP INFORMATION

\*All dogs & cats over 4 months of age kept, harbored, or maintained by citizens of the City of Osceola must be licensed every year at the city office. The cost is \$11.25 per year per animal and is due by April 30<sup>th</sup>. THE FACT THAT YOU MAY KEEP YOUR PET INDOORS AT ALL TIMES DOES NOT MEAN YOU DO NOT NEED TO LICENSE YOUR PET. You must bring your receipt from your veterinarian to the office as proof the animal is current on the rabies vaccination.

\*Keeping more than 2 dogs at one time over the age of 3 months requires a kennel permit.

\*It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or cat to allow the animal to run at large at any time within the corporate limits of the city. "Running at large" shall mean a dog or cat was found off the premises of the owner and not under control of the owner or a responsible person by leash, cord, chain, wire, rope, cage or other suitable means of physical restraint.

\*Pet owners need to pick up their dog droppings when walking them.

**\*City ban of certain breeds of dogs: *Staffordshire Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Chows, Doberman, Rottweiler, American Bandage Mastiff, Neopolitan Mastiff* or any dogs that have the appearance and characteristics of being predominately one or more of these breeds**
