Snow Season Reminders

- * As a general rule, when snow is predicted a snow emergency will be in effect for the entire City of Osceola.
- * No cars are to be parked on the following designated snow emergency routes when a snow emergency is in effect. The City can have vehicles towed at the owner's expense.
All of Central, Kimmel, State, Ridge, Valley and Nance Street
Beebe: Nance to Kimmel
Mickey: Valley to Kimmel
Hawkeye: Nance to Main
Main: Central to City Hall
Nebraska: State to Main
- * Please cooperate by not parking on other residential streets when possible to allow snow removal of the entire street.
- * Per City Ordinance, all snow, sleet and ice must be removed from all sidewalks within the corporate limits within 5 hours after the storm has ended. If the snow falls during the night, it is to be removed no later than 8:30 A.M. the following day.
- * In order for the City of Osceola to do a good job of snow removal, please keep trees overhanging the street trimmed. According to Section 6-107 of the City of Osceola Municipal Code book, the owner or occupant of any lot, piece or parcel of ground abutting or adjacent to any street or sidewalk over which the branches of trees extend shall at all times keep the branches or limbs thereof trimmed to a height of at least 7 ½ feet above the surface of said walk and at least 15 feet above the surface of said street.
